HANDLING/APPLICATION INFORMATION

Direction For Use:

- Surface Preparation: Surface must be clean, dry and dust free. Wiping with solvent such as Scotch-Grip™ Solvent No. 3 or Methyl Ethyl Ketone (MEK) will aid in removing oil or dirt.*
- 2. **Application:** This product is best applied by spatula, notched trowel or pressure-flow. "Butter" or trowel mastic to one surface. Bond within 5-10 minutes after spreading adhesive, pressing firmly to ensure intimate contact at all points.
- 3. **Drying Time:** Under normal drying conditions maximum strengths are usually achieved within 72 hours after bonding on porous surfaces with some exposure to air.
- 6. Cleanup: Excess adhesive may be removed with solvent such as Scotch-Grip Solvent No. 2 or MEK.*
 - *When using solvents, extinguish all sources of ignition and observe manufacturer's directions and precautions for handling such materials.

APPLICATION EQUIPMENT SUGGESTIONS

Appropriate application equipment enhances adhesive performance. We suggest the following application equipment for the user's evaluation in light of the user's particular purpose and method of application.

- 1. **Pumping:** A 9:1 ratio minimum, ball check type valve, 11 cu. in. displacement per cycle with a double acting 4½ air motor minimum. Use an inductor type follower plate with elevator. Packings and glands, in contact with the adhesive should be Teflon.*
 - *Teflon is a registered trademark of E.I. Dupont deNemours Co.
- 2. **Hoses:** Hoses, pipe fittings and pipe used to convey this material must be capable of withstanding the pressures developed by the recommended pump. All hoses should be nitrile, polysulfide or nylon lined.
- 3. Flow Guns: Tip seal type flow gun with 1/3" tip.
- 4. Pressure Filling Caulking Guns: Use same equipment as Nos. 1, 2 and 3 above.
- 5. **Manual Filling Caulking Guns:** Kenmar Manufacturing Co. Model 4T, Aro Corp. Model 611–402 hand gun filler with follower plate or Graco Model 225–975 gun loader with follower plate.

STORAGE AND SHELF LIFE

Storage:
